Evandria is the original Roman name of the village where the vines and surrounding estate are located. A name evoking the historic Roman influence in a land where the first vines were cultivated. Evandria, which in Greek means “good for the men”, was already known at the time for the production of good quality wines and olive oil. The singular nature of the Evandria soil attracted the attention of winemaker Amelia Coloma, who has ever since has dedicated herself to the Evandria project.

This is a light-to-medium bodied red with fantastic minerality and bright, snappy, sappy red fruits. Fruit jam, toasted spices, warm and terrifyingly easy to drink. Check out this “extreme” bargain while we have it!
