- Soil composition: Argillaceous, calcareous, rich in micro-elements
 - Training method: Guyot
 - Exposure: North-south
 - Vineyard age: 25 years

 - Vinification: 72 hours pre-fermentation cold maceration, soft pressing of the grapes, alcoholic fermentation at a controlled temperature and later maturation in steel basins for several months

Amber yellow, with light copper hints. Fine and elegant with sharp bouquet and persistent floral notes. Evident sensations of white fruit on the palate giving distinct freshness and sapidity.

Le Monde lies between the banks of the Livenza and Meduna rivers, close to the border between the provinces of Treviso and Pordenone in Friuli Grave. The winery headquarters, built in the eighteenth century maintains the architectural characteristics of the time. Originally property of the Pistoni family, the wine farm together with the vineyards was acquired Alex Maccan in 2008. Alex is now the owner and winemaker.
